1. Standing Order Regarding Children, Property and Conduct of the Parties -The District Judge and County Court at Law Judge, Bosque County, Texas have entered this Order. This order applies to all divorce petitions and suits affecting parent-child relationships, (except AG initiated cases and CPS cases), filed after February 18, 2011.

2. Requesting a Search- If the request is for criminal information, please mail in writing and include the party's date of birth, the full name, and the case/cause number, if known. If the case/cause number is not known, please include \$5.00 for each record search. If the request is for civil/family information, please include the case/cause number, name of parties if known. If the case/cause number is not known, please include an additional \$5.00 for each record search. We accept exact amount in cash in person, cashier's checks, or money orders made payable to Bosque County District Clerk.

3. Requesting copies- Contact our office with the pertinent information such as: last name or the other parties name, case/cause number, if known. This will enable our office to locate the file. Once we locate file and count the pages we will then call you back to let you know how many pages. Copies are \$1.00 per page, certified or non-certified. When mailing in payment please make sure we have the last name or the other parties name, case/cause number and include a self-address stamp envelope to mail back the documents. We accept exact amount in cash in person, cashier's checks, or money orders made payable to Bosque County District Clerk. Please send in self addressed stamped envelope for return of your copies.
