5) ORDER APPROVING OR DISAPPROVING TO PAY CLAIMS, SALARIES AND WAGES AGAINST COUNTY FUNDS

Commissioner Schmidt made the motion to approve to pay claims, salaries and wages of \$71,224.90. Commissioner Leach seconded the motion. All approved.

6) ORDER APPROVING OR DISAPPROVING TO PAY CLAIMS, SALARIES AND WAGES AGAINST PRECINCT FUNDS

Commissioner Koonsman made the motion to approve to pay claims, salaries and wages against precinct funds. Commissioner Schmidt seconded the motion. All approved.

8) DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING 2015 PROPOSED BUDGET AND 2015 PROPOSED ALLOCATIONS FOR BOSQUE COUNTY CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT

Commissioner Leach made the motion to table approval of Appraisal District proposed budget until the county budget is discussed regarding county employee compensation. Commissioner Day seconded the motion. All approved.

There is a meeting on the 30th regarding the courthouse. TAC is bringing their own engineering firm to look at the courthouse roof.

13) RECEIVE AND FILE CERTIFICATES FOR DEWEY RATLIFF, COUNTY JUDGE AND TIM JESKE, EMC

Commissioner Koonsman made the motion to receive and file the certificates. Commissioner Leach seconded the motion. All approved.
