A PROCLAMATION of the BOSQUE COUNTY JUDGE RECOGNIZING CHILD ABUSE AWARENESS AND PREVENTION MONTH April 2018

WHEREAS, our State received almost 500,000 reports that legally met the criteria for abuse, neglect or exploitation this past year; and

WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect is a serious problem affecting every segment of our community, and finding solutions requires input and action from everyone in our community; and

WHEREAS, regardless of who they are or circumstances of their birth, every child deserves care and to be kept safe from harm; and

WHEREAS, child abuse can have long-term psychological, emotional, and physical effects that can have lifelong consequences for victims of abuse; and

WHEREAS, keeping children safe from abuse means playing an active role in their lives, and teaching them the warning signs of abuse and how to protect themselves; and

WHEREAS, empowering our children and providing them with safe places to live, learn, and play is vital to keeping them safe from harm; and

WHEREAS, the Bosque County Child Protective Services Board will continue to provide educational materials at events within our county in an effort to prevent child abuse;

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED, I, Don Pool, Bosque County Judge, do hereby recognize April 2018 as CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH in Bosque County, and I call this observance to the attention of all of our citizens.
