Proclamation

National American Indian Heritage Month

the history and culture of our great nation have been significantly influenced by American WHEREAS, Indians and indigenous peoples; and WHEREAS, the contributions of American Indians have enhanced the freedom, prosperity, and greatness of America today, and their customs and traditions are respected and celebrated as part of a rich legacy WHEREAS, throughout the United States; and WHEREAS. Native American Awareness Week began in 1976 and recognition was expanded by Congress and approved by President George Bush in August 1990, designating the month of November, as National American Indian Heritage Month; and WHEREAS. in honor of National American Indian Heritage Month, community celebrations as well as numerous cultural, artistic, educational, and historical activities have been planned; NOW THEREFORE, I Don Pool , by virtue of the authority vested in me as County Judge of Bosque County, Texas do hereby proclaim November as the National American Indian Heritage Month, in Bosque County, Texas, and urge all our citizens to observe this month with appropriate programs, ceremonies and activities.
