# FIRST AMENDED APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL AS MUNIMENT OF TITLE

Applicant: Johnny K. Judah a/k/a John. K. Judah

Decedent: Betty Jo Judah

Applicant files this application for probate of the written Will of Decedent as Muniment of Title, and shows the Court as follows:

## 1. Applicant's Information

Applicant Johnny K. Judah, only child of Decedent and a person interested in this estate, is domiciled in Dallas County, Texas and may be served at 1200 Main St # 1206, Dallas, TX 75202.

#### 2. Decedent's Information

Decedent, Betty Jo Judah was domiciled in Bosque County, Texas at the time of her death. The last three digits of Decedent's social security number are 753. The last three digits of Decedent's driver's license are 706.

#### 3. Fact, Date, and Place of Death

Decedent died on July 1, 2023 in DeSoto, Dallas County, Texas.

#### 4. Jurisdiction and Venue

This Court has jurisdiction over this matter and venue is proper because Decedent resided in this county and had a domicile or fixed place of residence in Texas.

## 5. Property

Decedent owned personal property having an aggregate probable value of less than \$75,000.00 6. Medicaid Benefits Decedent did not receive Medicaid benefits on or after March 1, 2005.

## 7. Details of Will

Decedent executed a valid, written Will on June 1, 1991, which was never revoked.

## 8. Subscribing Witnesses to the Will

The subscribing witnesses to Decedent's will are: Charles G. Johnson and Edna Johnson.

#### 9. Executor Facts

Decedent's Will named Johnny Kevin Judah a/k/a John K. Judah (Applicant), son of Decedent, to serve as alternative Independent Executor without bond or security in the event that Jimmy Donald Judah, husband of Decedent, was unable to act.

Decedent died on July 1, 2023. Jimmy Donald Judah, husband of Decedent, subsequently died on August 11, 2023 without undertaking any action or administration on Decedent's estate. An Affidavit of Heirship regarding Jimmy Donald Judah was executed by Applicant recorded as Instrument No. 2023-03918 of the Official Public Records of Bosque County, Texas. A copy of the Affidavit of Heirship regarding Jimmy Donald Judah is attached hereto.

Johnny K. Judah, Applicant and son of Decedent, resides at 1200 Main St # 1206, Dallas, TX 75202. Johnny K. Judah may be served at 1200 Main St # 1206, Dallas, TX 75202.

## 10. After-Born Children

No children were born to or adopted by Decedent after execution of the Will.

## 11. No Unsecured, Unpaid Debt

Decedent's estate does not owe an unpaid debt, and there is no necessity for administration on the estate.

## 12. Divorce After Execution of Will

Decedent was never divorced after making her Will.

## 13. Government Agency or Chrity Named as Devisee

Decedent's will does not name the State of Texas, an agency of the State, or a charitable organization as a devisee.

## 14. Time Between Date of Death and Application

Four years have not elapsed since the date of Decedent's death and before this Application.

## 15. Prior Affidavit of Heirship and Small Estate Affidavit

As the sole heir of Decedent, Applicant originally chose to inherit without probating Decedent's will because there was no need for any administration. Applicant recorded an Affidavit of Heirship regarding Decedent to accomplish that purpose, and it was recorded as Instrument No. 2023-03919 of the Official Public Records of Bosque County, Texas (Exhibit A). The Affidavit of Heirship regarding Decedent sufficed to transfer the ownership interest of all assets from Decedent's estate into Applicant – except for one account.

Fidelity Investments informed Applicant that an Affidavit of Heirship would be acceptable to the company, but then refused to accept the Affidavit of Heirship and demanded Applicant file a Small Estate Affidavit.

Pursuant to Fidelity's demands, Applicant filed a Small Estate Affidavit. The Court denied the Small Estate Affidavit because Decedent had left a Will. Fidelity Investments now requires Applicant to undertake this probate as muniment of title to retrieve the only remaining asset in Decedent's estate.

#### 16. Reason for Nonproduction of Decedent's Will

As stated above, Applicant has previously attempted to inherit the property of Decedent's Estate under the Texas intestacy statutes. Decedent's Will was attached as an exhibit to the Affidavit of Heirship and the Small Estate Affidavit. Applicant has now misplaced the original Will, but a certified copy of the Affidavit of Heirship in which the Will was included as an exhibit is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

#### 17. Prayer

Applicant requests that, as provided in Section 257.053 of the Texas Estates Code, Decedent's Will be admitted to probate as muniment of title without any administration of the Will or estate required, and that this Court enter all other orders it deems proper.
