

**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL
AND FOR ISSUANCE OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY**

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

CRYSTAL TURNER (“Applicant”) furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of JIMMY W. TURNER, (“Decedent”) and for issuance of Letters Testamentary to Applicant:

1. Applicant, CRYSTAL TURNER is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled and residing at 309 G. Street, Meridian, Texas 76665. The last three digits of, CRYSTAL TURNER’s Drivers License Number are xxxxx345. The last three digits of, CRYSTAL TURNER’s social security number are xxx-xx-x385.
2. Decedent died on September 21, 2024, in Meridian, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 68 years. The last three digits of Decedent’s social security number are xxx-xx-x148.
3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence at 309 G. Street, Meridian, Texas 76665 on the date of Decedent’s death.
4. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as a home, a vehicle, household goods, and personal effects, of a probable value of approximately \$75,000.00.
5. Decedent left a valid written Will (“Will”) dated September 19, 2024 which was never revoked and is filed herewith.
6. The subscribing witnesses to the Will are Kent Bratcher whose present address is 113 W. River, Meridian, Texas 76665 and Domanic Allen whose present address is 268 CR 2620, Morgan, Texas 76671 and the Will is self proved.

7. No child or children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.
8. No marriage of the Decedent was dissolved after the date of the Will (See Section 256.052 Estates Code).
9. A necessity exists for the administration of this estate.
10. Decedent's Will named Applicant to serve as Independent Executor without bond or other security and Applicant would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting Letters Testamentary, and Applicant would be entitled to such Letters.
11. Decedent's Will did not name either the State of Texas, a governmental agency of the State of Texas, or a charitable organization as a devisee.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that Letters Testamentary be issued to Applicant as Independent Executor without bond; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
