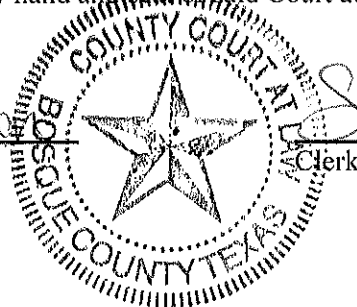
All persons interested in said cause are hereby cited to appear before said Honorable Court at said above mentioned time and place by filing a written answer contesting said request if they so desire.



APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF GUARDIANS OF THE PERSON

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

NOW COMES, RAYMOND LEE ROBERTS and JENNIFER EVELYN ROBERTS (hereinafter referred to as "Applicants"), and would respectfully show the Court the following:

I.

Applicants seek to be appointed guardians of the person of WALKER LEE ROBERTS (hereinafter referred to as "Proposed Ward").

II.

Proposed Ward is an adult male whose date of birth is October 3, 2006 and who resides at 177 C.R. 2700, Walnut Springs, Texas, 76690, where he may be served with citation.

III.

Applicants, RAYMOND LEE ROBERTS and JENNIFER EVELYN ROBERTS, who reside at 177 C.R. 2700, Walnut Springs, Texas, 76690, are Proposed Ward's father and mother and he is currently in their care and custody. Applicants are qualified to serve as Guardians of Proposed Ward.

IV.

Proposed Ward resides in this county; accordingly, this Court has venue over these proceedings.

V.

Proposed Ward is mentally incapacitated by reason of intellectual and developmental disabilities. His mental incapacity results in his inability to care for himself and manage his personal affairs. Therefore, it is necessary and appropriate that Guardians be appointed to care for Proposed Ward, to manage his personal affairs, to protect him and to enforce his legal rights.

VI.

Proposed Ward has no spouse or children. Applicants are Proposed Ward's father and mother. Proposed Ward has two siblings, JACKSON OWEN ROBERTS, age 20, and PRESLEY PAGE ROBERTS, age 18, both of whom reside at 177 C.R. 2700, Walnut Springs, Texas, 76699, and have executed Waivers of Notice by Siblings to be filed in this case.

VII.

Applicants anticipate that Proposed Ward's mental incapacity will continue indefinitely. Accordingly, Applicants request that the term of the guardianship run indefinitely, until such time, if any, that this Court finds that Proposed Ward obtains mental capacity to the extent that a guardianship of his person is no longer needed.

VIII.

Following is a listing of areas of protection and assistance required by Proposed Ward as a result of his mental incapacity. Applicants request an Order Appointing Guardian of the Person

granting full authority over Proposed Ward. If the Court deems it necessary to specifically identify the powers of the Guardian of the Person, Applicants request an Order providing for protection and assistance for Proposed Ward in these areas:

1. collecting and filing suits on debts, rentals, wages and other claims;
2. paying, compromising and defending claims;
3. contracting and incurring obligations;
4. entering into obligations and purchases;
5. applying for and receiving funds from governmental sources or, in the alternative, executing binding waivers of funds to be received from governmental sources;
6. applying for and consenting to governmental services;
7. applying for consenting to and enrolling in non-residential programs and services which are reasonably required and needed by Proposed Ward and which are operated by public and private agencies and facilities;
8. making application for, consenting to and enrolling in public and private residential care facilities;
9. making employment decisions;
10. applying for, arranging for and consenting to any and all psychological and psychiatric tests and evaluations, including, but not limited to, a comprehensive diagnosis and evaluation;
11. consenting to the disclosure of psychological records and medical records;
12. consenting to major medical and dental treatment and testing, including surgery, psychotropic drugs and including the choice of physician or dentist, excluding sterilization and minor medical problems such as cuts, bruises, colds, etc.;
13. applying, consenting to and enrolling in appropriate educational services;

14. making decisions related to military service; and
15. entering or procuring insurance contracts of every nature..

IX.

Applicant requests that WALKER LEE ROBERTS's rights be limited as follows:

- a. WALKER LEE ROBERTS shall no longer have the right to hold or obtain a license to operate a motor vehicle;
- b. WALKER LEE ROBERTS shall no longer have the right to make decisions involving his marital status.
- c. WALKER LEE ROBERTS ITH shall no longer have the right to make any gifts of real or personal property.
- d. WALKER LEE ROBERTS shall no longer have the right to make personal decisions regarding residence.
- e. No request is made regarding WALKER LEE ROBERTS's right to vote in public elections.

X.

Applicant is not aware of the existence of a guardianship in this or any other state for WALKER LEE ROBERTS.

XI.

Applicant is not aware of any person holding a power of attorney signed by WALKER LEE ROBERTS.

XII.

Applicants considered alternatives to guardianship and available supports and services to avoid guardianship, but determined that they were not feasible for WALKER LEE ROBERTS and would not avoid the need for guardianship for WALKER LEE ROBERTS.


XIII.

WALKER LEE ROBERTS has no estate or significant property. Accordingly, a guardianship of the estate is not needed and Applicant requests that the costs of this proceeding, including the Attorney ad Litem's fee, be paid by Bosque County pursuant to Sections 1151.002 and 1151.151 of the Texas Estates Code.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Applicants pray that notice of this Application be given as required by law; that Proposed Ward be personally served with citation to appear and answer this Application; that an attorney ad litem and/or guardian ad litem be appointed to represent Proposed Ward; that upon hearing hereof, Applicants be appointed Guardians of the Person; and that Letters of Guardianship be issued to Applicants upon taking the Oath and giving Bond as required by law.

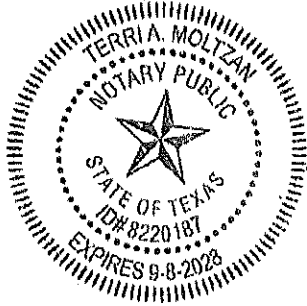


