

**APPLICATION TO PROBATE WILL and FIRST CODICIL AND**  
**FOR ISSUANCE OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY**

**TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:**

CHARLES JAHNS ("Applicant"), furnishes the following information to the Court in support of this Application for the probate of the Will and First Codicil to the Will of BARBARA L. JAHNS ("Decedent"), and for issuance of Letters Testamentary:

1. Applicant, CHARLES JAHNS, is an individual interested in this Estate, being domiciled in and residing in Texas. CHARLES JAHNS's address for service of citation is 721 S. Taylor St., Hamilton, Texas 76531. The last three digits of the social security number of CHARLES JAHNS are 669. The last three digits of the driver's license number of CHARLES JAHNS are 019. The last three digits of the social security number of BARBARA L. JAHNS are 938. The last three digits of the driver's license number of BARBARA L. JAHNS are 933.
2. Decedent died on March 1, 2024 at Clifton, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 89 years. Decedent's domicile at the time of her death was Bosque County, Texas.
3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue is proper because Decedent was domiciled in Texas and had a fixed place of residence in this County on the date of her death.
4. Decedent owned property described generally as cash, personal effects and household goods of a probable value of approximately \$200,000.00.
5. Decedent left a valid Will dated December 3, 2019, which was never revoked. Decedent left a valid First Codicil to the Will dated October 10, 2022, which was never revoked. A true and correct copy of the Will and First Codicil are filed with the Court. The Will and First Codicil, will be delivered to the County Clerk pursuant to the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.
6. A necessity exists for the administration of the Estate.
7. After the date of the Will and First Codicil, no child was born to or adopted by Decedent.
8. No marriage of the Decedent was ever dissolved after the will and First Codicil were made.

9. Decedent's First Codicil to the Last Will and Testament named CHARLES JAHNS to serve as Independent Executor to act independently without bond or other security. CHARLES JAHNS resides in Hamilton, Hamilton County, Texas. CHARLES JAHNS is not disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting Letters Testamentary, and is entitled to such letters.

10. No state, governmental agency of the state, nor charitable organization is named by the Will or the Codicil to the Will as a devisee.

11. The Will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law and the subscribing witnesses to the Will are Connie Z. White and Nan Campbell. The First Codicil to the Will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law and the subscribing witnesses to the First Codicil to the Will are Connie Z. White and Nan Campbell.

WHEREFORE, Applicants pray that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will and First Codicil to the Will be admitted to probate; that Letters Testamentary be issued to CHARLES JAHNS; and that all other Orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
