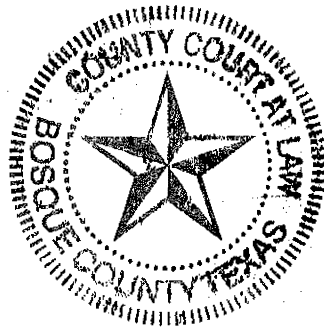


TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

SONYA KING (“Applicant”) furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of ERIC WILLIAM KING, (“Decedent”) and for issuance of Letters Testamentary to Applicant:


1. Applicant, SONYA KING is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled and residing at 1912 CR 2960, Kopperl, Texas 76652. The last three digits of, SONYA KING’s, Drivers License Number are xxxxx328. The last three digits of, SONYA KING’s social security number are xxx-xx-x827.
2. Decedent died on December 12, 2024 in Kopperl, Bosque County, Texas, at the age of 53 years. The last three digits of Decedent’s social security number are xxx-xx-x917..
3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence at 20285 FM 56, Kopperl, Texas 76652, on the date of Decedent’s death.
4. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as a vehicle, household goods, and personal effects, of a probable of approximately \$25,000.00.
5. Decedent left a valid written Will (“Will”) dated December 19, 2023, which was never revoked and is filed herewith.
6. The subscribing witnesses to the Will are Christy Covey whose present address is Granbury, Texas and Cindy Henry whose present address is Glen Rose, Texas and the Will is self proved.

7. No child or children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.
8. No marriage of the Decedent was dissolved after the date of the Will (See Section 256.052 Estates Code).
9. A necessity exists for the administration of this estate.
10. Decedent's Will named Applicant to serve as Independent Executor without bond or other security and Applicant would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting Letters Testamentary, and Applicant would be entitled to such Letters.
11. Decedent's Will did not name either the State of Texas, a governmental agency of the State of Texas, or a charitable organization as a devisee.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that Letters Testamentary be issued to Applicant as Independent Executor without bond; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
