At the time of her death, the Decedent was permanently domiciled in Bosque County, Texas, and her principal property was situated in Bosque County, Texas.

The Decedent owned real and personal property, including real property, bank accounts, and cash in excess of \$50,000.00.

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The Decedent left a Will (Will) dated October 29, 2015.
