RESOLUTION-ALPR

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF BOSQUE COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF TO ENTER INTO A MULTI-USE-AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ALLOWING THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION CAMERAS IN TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RIGHT-OF-WAY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of the County of Bosque has determined the addition of Automatic License Crime Prevention efforts and strategies; and

WHEREAS, The Commissioners Court Desires to engage with the Texas Department of Public Transportation (TXDOT) and ask that Flock Safety be allowed to place ALRP Cameras in TXDOT right-of-way's on behalf of the County of Bosque; and

WHEREAS, The Commissioners Court finds it to be in the public interest to authorize the Sheriff to sign a Multiple-Use Agreement with TXDOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF BOSQUE COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The Commissioners Court hereby authorizes the Sheriff to enter into a Multiple-Use Agreement with TXDOT for the installation and operation of ALPR Camera in TXDOT right-of way's.

SECTION 2.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the adoption.
