5. Decedent left a valid, written Will dated December 6, 1995, *the Will*, which was never revoked and is filed in this cause.

6. The subscribing witnesses to the Will were Cathy Hill, who, at the time of the Will's execution, resided at 216 Oklahoma, Hewitt, McLennan County, Texas 76643 & Cynthia Straten, who, at the time of the Will's execution resided at 1300 N. Reagan St. #208, West, McLennan County, Texas 76691. The Will was self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.

7. Decedent was married five times. Decedent's first marriage was to Mr. Slaughter, whose first name is unknown to Applicant, which ended in divorce between the years 1963-1966 in Concho County, Texas. Of this marriage, only one child was born:

Michelle Slaughter, who died in 1963 at the age of approximately 3 days old.

Decedent's second marriage was to Mr. Durosset, whose first name is unknown to Applicant, which ended in divorce around 1970 in Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas. No children were born of this marriage.

Decedent's third marriage, whose name is unknown to Applicant, ended in divorce in the 1970s. No children were born of this marriage.

Decedent's fourth marriage was to John Kromer, which ended in divorce in the year 1985 in Concho County, Texas. Of this marriage, only two children were born:

Christy Nicole Kromer, an adult, residing at 1510 W. 9th Street, Clifton, Bosque County, Texas 76634; and

Preston Coy Kromer, who died in 1983 at the age of 3 years old.

Decedent's fifth and final marriage was to Norman Ray Robbins, which ended in his death on July 5, 2024 in Bosque County, Texas. No children were born of this marriage.

No other child was ever born to Decedent, adopted by Decedent, or taken into Decedent's home with the understanding of adoption.

None of Decedent's marriages were dissolved after the date of the Will.

8. A necessity exists for administration of this estate.

9. Neither Texas, nor any governmental agency of Texas, nor any charitable organization is named in the Will as a devisee. The Will's sole beneficiary is Applicant and is Decedent's daughter.

10. Decedent did not apply for or receive Medicaid benefits on or after March 1, 2005.

11. Decedent's Will named Applicant to serve without bond or other security as Independent Executor, and Applicant would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting *Letters Testamentary*, and Applicant would be entitled to such Letters.

12. Decedent's Will (paragraph VI) grants the Independent Executor full power and authority over Decedent's assets, including the power to sell, manage and dispose of Decedent's property.

13. Pursuant to *Texas Estates Code Section 256.052(b)*, no information required for this Application has been omitted.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that *Letters Testamentary* be issued to Applicant; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
