**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Tracy Whitt, ("Applicant"), whose social security number is xxx-xx-x890, and whose driver's license number is xxxxx781. Applicant furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of *James Halfrey Cheatam* ("Decedent"), and for issuance of Letters Testamentary to Applicant:

1. Applicant is an individual interested in this Estate, domiciled in and residing at 1582 CR 2730, Glen Rose, Bosque County, Texas 76043.
2. Decedent died at Waterview, The Cove Assisted Living and Memory Care, Granbury, Hood County, Texas 76048 on February 17, 2025, at 89 years of age.
3. Four years have not elapsed since the date of his death.
4. Decedent's Social Security Number is xxx-xx-x575, and his Texas Driver's License number is xxxxx726.
5. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent was domiciled and had a fixed place of residence in this county on the date of death.
6. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as a home, cash, securities, an automobile, household goods, and personal effects of a value more than \$100,000.00.
7. Decedent left a valid Will ("Will") dated May 31, 2021, which was never revoked.

8. The subscribing witnesses to this Will are *Judith A. D'Amico* and *Thomas X D'Amico* whose address at the time was 1322 FM 205, Glen Rose, Somervell County, Texas 76043.

9. The Will was made self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.

10. No child or children were born to or adopted by Decedent after the date of the Will.

11. There has been no dissolution of marriage of Decedent after the date of the Will.

12. A necessity exists for the administration of this Estate.

13. Decedent's Will named Applicant to serve without bond or other security as Independent Executrix, and Applicant would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting Letters Testamentary, and Applicant would be entitled to such Letters.

14. Neither the state, a governmental agency of the state, or any charitable organization is named by the Will as a devisee.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that Letters Testamentary be issued to Applicant; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
