**APPLICATION FOR PROBATE OF WILL
AND ISSUANCE OF LETTERS TESTAMENTARY**

To the Honorable Judge of the Court:

Glenda Nell Weaver, *Applicant*, furnishes the following information to the Court for the probate of the written Will of Audrey Nell Cox, *Decedent*, and for issuance of *Letters Testamentary*:

1. Applicant is an individual interested in this estate, domiciled in and residing at 1505 Blanchard Drive, Round Rock, Williamson County, Texas 78681-6217. The last three digits of Applicant's Social Security and Texas driver's license numbers are 856 and 595, respectively.

2. Decedent died on January 22, 2025, at Beacon Hospice of Austin in Round Rock, Williamson County, Texas, at the age of 93 years. The last three digits of Decedent's Social Security number and Texas driver's license numbers are 212 and 252, respectively.

3. This Court has jurisdiction and venue because Decedent owned property interests in this county.

4. Decedent owned real and personal property described generally as homestead and other real estate in Coryell & Bosque Counties, Texas, savings bonds, bank accounts, household goods and personal effects of a probable value of less than \$2,000,000.

5. Decedent left a valid, written Will dated October 29, 2007, *the Will*, which was never revoked and is filed in this cause.

6. The subscribing witnesses to the Will were Jean Ann Smith, who currently resides in or near Clifton, Bosque County, Texas, and Patricia (Coy) Ferguson, who currently resides in or near China Spring, Texas. The Will was self-proved in the manner prescribed by law.

7. Decedent was married only once and then to Glenn Dale Cox, who predeceased her in 2017 in Bosque County, Texas. Of this marriage, only two children were born:

Glenda Nell Weaver (Applicant) now an adult, residing at 1505 Blanchard Drive, Round Rock, Williamson County, Texas 78681-6217; and

Clifford Don Cox, now an adult, residing at 4117 Shamrock Drive, Arlington, Tarrant County, Texas 76016-4430.

No other child was ever born to Decedent, adopted by Decedent, or taken into Decedent's home with the understanding of adoption.

None of Decedent's marriages were dissolved after the date of the Will.

8. A necessity exists for administration of this estate.

9. Neither Texas, nor any governmental agency of Texas, nor any charitable organization is named in the Will as a devisee. The Will's equal share beneficiaries are Decedent's children shown in paragraph 7. above.

10. Decedent did not apply for or receive Medicaid benefits on or after March 1, 2005.

11. Decedent's Will named Applicant to serve without bond or other security as Independent Executor, and Applicant would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting *Letters Testamentary*, and Applicant would be entitled to such Letters.

12. Decedent's Will (paragraph VI.) grants the Independent Executor full power and authority over Decedent's assets, including the power to sell, manage and dispose of Decedent's property.

13. Pursuant to *Texas Estates Code Section 256.052(b)*, no information required for this Application has been omitted.

Applicant prays that citation issue as required by law to all persons interested in this Estate; that the Will be admitted to probate; that *Letters Testamentary* be issued to Applicant; and that all other orders be entered as the Court may deem proper.
